

## **Materials**

36 Word cards 36Picture cards

9 Top cards (optional) the cards may be copied on each card for security so the kiddos can't see through.

Print the set of Word and picture cards on one color of cardstock or paper. (To make a class set, print the cards on different colors of cardstock.) Laminate for durability. Cut the cards apart.

## To play,

Place all word cards face down in the playing area.


Distribute the picture cards to the players.

One of players take a turn drawing a card from the table, says the word . (I usually have my table captain choose first.)

If the kiddo draws a word card that matches their picture card, they set it aside and take another turn.

If another player has the match, that kiddo takes the card and it becomes their turn to draw.

The first player to get rid of all cards on their plate is the first winner. The kiddos watch until all are finished. There is a 1<sup>st</sup> winner, 2<sup>nd</sup> winner, 3<sup>rd</sup> winner and 4<sup>th</sup> winner. The kiddos love the Magic e game.







